Application Checklist

Scholarship application – must be neat, legible and with all questions answered.

2 letters of recommendation – one letter should be from someone willing to speak of the candidate’s academic achievement; the other letter should be from someone familiar with candidate’s community involvement. Both letters should speak on candidate’s character and potential.

Current academic HS transcript (official) – should include class rank and size, candidate’s overall GPA.

Send an unofficial report of SAT or ACT score. Unofficial scores may be obtained from College Board on the web or from your high school.

All application materials **must** be **submitted** to the following mailing address and/or email address no later than **April 15, 2024**. Letters of recommendation may be emailed and/or mailed separate from other materials but must be received by the deadline. Incomplete material and/or late applications will render candidate’s ineligible for consideration for this scholarship. All scholarship packets: recommendation letters, transcripts, and application must be **mailed to the address**
