APPLICATION DUE DATE: All applications must be postmarked by April 15, 2024. The winning applicant will be notified of our selection by April 30.

ELIGIBILITY: This scholarship will be awarded to a student in any KS county in which we have a member of our association in good standing. This is a one-time \$1,000 scholarship awarded to a high school senior who will pursue a 2 or 4-year college degree or attend a technical school pursuing a career. This scholarship will be awarded to a student whose GPA falls between 2.50 and 3.75.

AWARD: A check will be sent after July 1 to the school selected by the recipient upon obtaining further information from the recipient.

APPLICATION: All applications shall be in 12 pt. font and <u>must</u> be signed by the applicant. The application shall be 1 page, which will include the following information, plus a 7-semester transcript from the school.
